## Renal Implications of Advances in Immunology and Inflammation

The Immunology Work Group (IWG) within the ERA-EDTA organizes in collaboration with the Swedish Society of Nephrology (SNF) and the Mayo Clinic this CME course.

The course is primarily intended for young specialists in Nephrology who want to deepen their knowledge in Immunology and to understand how progress in this field can influence the care of patients with renal disease. The course is, however, open to anyone who wants to attend.

The course is a satellite meeting just prior to the Congress of the Nordic Society of Nephrology, and delegates attending both events are granted a discount on the tuition fee. However, participation in the course does not require participation in the Congress or vice versa.
